What is Reported?

Credit progress for students toward graduation.

CORE Area Codes

Subject Area and/or CORE Requirements area in which a student has earned credits/units towards graduation

**For VALID CORE Area Codes see section 2.15 Student Graduation - Core Summary

Reporting Instructions:

Report the most specific option that would apply.

Example: If a student takes a business course as an elective, report the "BUS" option instead of the "ELE" option since the "BUS" option is more specific.

REMINDER:

"ELE" - Elective units are <u>not</u> counting as elective credit for state graduation requirements

CORE Area Count

Includes:

- Courses taken in the district that will award the diploma
- Courses taken at other education organizations but transferred to and accepted for credit by the district that will award the diploma, and
- Any other experiences for which the district that will award the diploma had awarded credits towards graduation for the student, subject to any relevant local and state policies (see EMIS Manual section 2.15 for those relevant exceptions)




CORE Area Count

Reporting Instructions:

Include all credits/units recognized by the district that grants the diploma, even if the count is greater than the minimum CORE graduation requirement.

Dual Enrollment Credit Earned

The total number of Dual Enrollment credits earned in the area designated by Core Area Code.

Reporting Instructions:

Include **ALL** college credits earned through dual enrollment courses (whether offered as part of a specific dual enrollment program or a statewide articulation agreement) if they are listed on an official document or transcript issued by the college or university that granted the credit.

Student Information > General > Transcript



To build an AdHoc showing "Dual Enrollment Credit Earned" you are looking for TranscriptCourse.transcriptField2

The report is only going to show courses that have been posted to transcript.

Districts must use the "Post To Transcript" option for all courses earned at the district or at a college.

You **should not manually add anything to the transcript except move in credits or Summer School credits.
