Interactive Custom Form with Database Tables, and now Blank and Interactive Form types can be versioned to preserve the configuration from a previous version. Allowing users to correct Typos, update verbiage or have a new form for the next school year and keep a view of how the form was changed over time.

- All mappings, database configuration, and rules are copied from the previous form version.
- Existing mappings and rules can be modified, but the existing database configuration cannot be changed. Only new fields can be modified.
- The new version of the form is not active until a Start Date is entered and that day has been reached.

Transportation 2.0:

Once Transportation 2.0 has been enabled on any of your sites, **you cannot switch back to the previous version.** Existing transportation integration will 'break' and transportation data will no longer appear in the interface, outside of Ad hoc reporting.

Transportation 2.0 functionality:

- ❖ Assign multiple routes per student, making it easier to manage students living in multiple households or attending after-school activities.
- ❖ Staff can submit transportation request on behalf of families.
- ❖ Create active, future and inactive routes within each student profile.

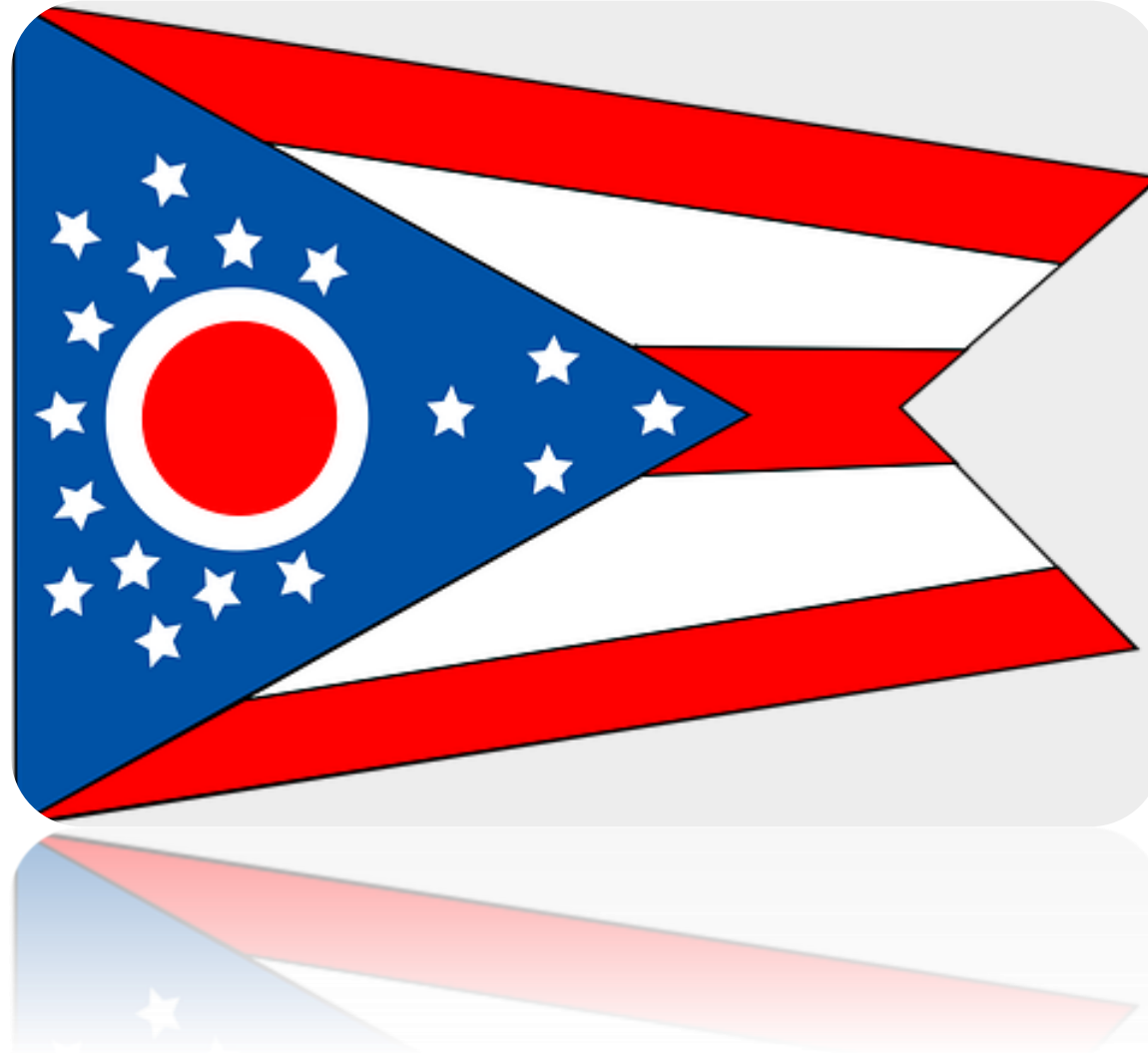
Enhancements:

--	Category	Details
2543	Academic Planner	To accommodate the need to identify students who have completed all requirements for any CTE program, including inactive students the Course Plan Administration has updated Student Statuses. The Batch Program Assignment Wizard also has the option to include inactive student with completed requirements in the selected school year.
2607	Dependent Care	The Attendance Registry Report is available, and Users are no longer required to assign a registration fee to a session
2607	Food Services	POS Version 3.3.4 now prevents returned change from depositing on an account, and updated POS Patron end date when end dating a District Employment.
2543	Instruction	A link to “Go to Student Information” has been added to the student detail side panel in various tools throughout Instruction. The link will open the Student Information menu in a new tab, where teachers can select which tool to view, based on tool rights.
2543	Learning	An option has been added to set a Time Limit for Quizzes. When a timer is set, it displays for students when they’re working on a quiz, and when it expires the quiz is automatically submitted with whatever work the student has completed at that point.
2607	Messenger	Improved Mailgun email dispatch for Large Messenger campaigns without Campus Fields/Sub-Reports.
2607	Online Payments	The Deposit Reporter will now retain all requested deposits and deposit details, even if a deposit fails. Failed deposits will be marked with a “Cancelled, exception or Revoked” status instead of being deleted.
2603	Scheduling	The Scheduling board supports semester-based scheduling: Using the board separately for each semester, Level courses and create student schedules for individual semesters and adjust schedules between semesters based on student's progress.
2603	Transcript	Credit Type is now a required field when adding new or modifying existing student transcript records.

Corrections:

--	Category	Details
2607	Academic Planning	The Course plan should no longer lock prohibiting students from adding courses to their course plan. Course Recommendation should now save for Teachers.
2603	Campus Learning	The Filters button on the Scoring Screen from Progress Monitor is now functioning as expected.
2543	Combine Person	The Combine Person Wizard was failing to keep directories, which was causing the tool to fail before finishing a merge, leading to data loss. This has been rectified.
2551	Messenger	Future scheduled teacher messages should now send on scheduled date, even if the message includes "inbox" devices.
2603	Google Integration	Google Drive updated its permission enforcement to where users will need at least full edit rights to a file that is in a folder they own. Districts who use Google Drive Integration must take the release to keep using the integration. Lastly, it has been updated that permission to YouTube account is no longer needed to use the Google Drive integration.
2603	Online Payments	An issue was resolved in which checking and savings accounts were still appearing as a payment type, when the eChecks setting was turned off.

--	Record	Details
2535	CTE	The CTE Program of Concentration field was added to the OH Academic and Graduation Program tool.
2551	Delivery Method	The Section Delivery Method Override field is updated to align with the Delivery options for the Course itself. This change eliminates the need for manual file updates when reporting Delivery Method changes during the SY.
2539	DN	New report population and field logic were added to the DN extract for the new student group C_STUEEPOL. The District Groups EDUMODELDB and LEAPRVWIFI no longer report.
2551	FD	The Disadvantage column now correctly reports from Student Enrollment records on the FD Extract.
2547	FE	The FE Extract is updated to contain 2 versions of the same file. FE Original is the default without changes. The FE Proposed was added to report a record for all active IEPs with an exemption, even when an exemption category is not selected.
2603	FF & FG	The report population was updated for the Student Contact (FF) and Student Contact Address (FG) Records to report emancipated students.
2547	Financial	Financial Literacy has been added to the Subject Area for Credit dropdown list in the Core Attribute Dictionary.
2535	FW	Additional options were added to the Other Follow-up Status dropdown on the FW tool. The sequence of values was also updated.
2543	Literacy	The existing Attribute Dictionary for the District Literacy Instruction Information Codes field was unlocked for Ohio
2539	PreID	The PreID extract was deprecated for OHIO, and the PreID Extract (Current) was updated to the New Look of Campus
2607	SpecEd	The 3GRG PDF, in the Exemptions Editor of the IEP was updated to the latest version of the ODE website
2607	SpecEd	Validation was added to the Exemptions editor on the IEP 2019.2 print format so that when "Is the child excused from the consequences" is Yes, at least 1 test record with a Category, Course Title and Justification must be created to save.
